



Xerox pioneered the practice of remanufacturing, reusing and the recycling of office equipment. Xerox UK customers have the following options to recycle and responsibly dispose of Xerox® equipment in line with the EU WEEE (Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment) regulation.

The following Xerox® products are covered for pick-up for reuse or recycling from a customer site when existing equipment is being replaced.

- Leased products on a Xerox® Full Service Maintenance Agreement
- Leased products on a Xerox® PagePack® or Xerox® eClick® Program upon renewal
- Products under a Xerox® Managed Print Services Program upon renewal
- Sold products which are classed as B2B

According to the EU-WEEE directive, products that can be used in businesses as well as in private households are to be classed as B2C products. For B2C products, Xerox is participating in the [ERP WEEE compliance scheme](#). Customers can return those products for recycling via any of the collection centres approved under the WEEE Regulations free of charge. The participating producers pay the costs for further processing.

For the collection of Xerox® products purchased through indirect sales channels, we recommend contacting the relevant Xerox partner. Xerox partners can return end-of-life equipment for re-use and recycling. Xerox will cover the cost for recycling.

The UK WEEE Producer Registration number is WEE/CH0092VV for UK and WEE/MM1269AA for Northern Ireland.
